

## CREDIT LINE

The credit line and *Shakespeare in American Communities* logo must be included on, but not limited to, the title page of programs, educational materials, advertisements, brochures, posters, and newsletters. The *Shakespeare in American Communities* logo and credit line must also be included, but limited to, theater company's Web site, preferably on the home/splash page with a link to [www.ShakespeareInAmericanCommunities.org](http://www.ShakespeareInAmericanCommunities.org). Graphic standards related to the proper usage of the log and credit line are explained in the Standards Manual.

The following credit line must be used in all printed materials and digital communications related to performances and educational activities. Font size for the credit line should be consistent with the majority of type in your materials and, generally, not smaller than 10-point type.
